

# EMERGENCY CONTRACEPTION (EC) ("MORNING AFTER PILL")

## IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER

- ⇒ Vaginal bleeding WILL happen sometime in the next 3 weeks after you take Plan B. Bleeding may be heavy, light, or stop and restart.
- ⇒ Your period may be early, late, or mixed up. Don't worry. This is normal after Plan B.
- ⇒ Bleeding does NOT mean you are pregnant and does NOT mean you are having a miscarriage. Plan B CANNOT cause a miscarriage nor hurt you if you are already pregnant.
- ⇒ If you DO NOT get any vaginal bleeding within 3 weeks after taking Plan B, call the Women's Clinic for an appointment at 486-4837.
